HORSE PROGRAM CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ALL COMPETITORS TO SIGN AN INDEMNITY WAIVER PRIOR TO RIDING ON THE GROUNDS.

A.S. APPROVED SAFETY HELMETS MUST BE WORN ON THE SHOWGROUNDS BY ALL COMPETITORS WHILE MOUNTED AT ALL TIMES AS PER STANDARDS ASSOCIATION.

NOTE: This Show is run under the Regulations & Guidelines of Equestrian Australia. For further information refer to EA's website: www.efanational.com

- Individual entry fees - \$3 unless otherwise specified. (GST included).
- District – to reside within 50 km of Rutherglen Post Office
- Novice - Horse that has never won a first prize at an agricultural show or EFA qualifying open Gymkhana.
- Registration papers for all breed Classes must be produced if requested.
- Handlers and riders of stallions and colts must be 18 years and over.
- Stallions and colts 2 years and over must wear an appropriate bit.
- Welsh Pony yearlings may be shown in a halter.
- Ponies & Horses may only enter either open or show hunter classes, not both.
- When framing the schedule every endeavor has been made to avoid the judging of two classes at the same time in which one exhibitor may be interested. However, delaying judging for competitors will be at the judges or stewards discretion on the day.
- The Committee reserved the right to alter or omit any Prize items.
- Drug testing may be carried out at this Show.
- The Judge shall award Reserve Champion Sashes in Horse and Rider Events where stipulated. Second prize to the Champion in the Section shall be allowed to compete for the Reserve Champion Sash.
- Winners of Champion Classes in Double Chance Ring for ridden Hack, Galloway & Ponies NOT ELIGIBLE to compete for Champion in the second Ring.
- First, Second and Third ribbons in all Sections. Prize money or trophies where stipulated.
- All prizes are available on Show Day. Prizes not collected on the day will be forfeited.
- Owners entering livestock do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry in any event that no liability of any kind attaches to the Society, the Committee, Officials and Members in any respect whatsoever. The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through, or by, any exhibit and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such an accident.
- **By competing exhibitors consent to having photographs taken during the Show which may be used by the Society for promotional and publicity purposes in media including social media**

Off The Track Series – Qualifiers Regulations

1. Open to all thoroughbreds unraced or raced 4yrs and over, over 14.2 hands who are registered with RISA and must have had one official trial.
(Racing Information Services Australia). Registrations will be checked
2. Racing/Trial name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name and the following details (if known)
 - Racing name
 - Brands, colour and markings
 - Microchip number
 - Life Number
 - Registration Certificate Number
 - Dam and Sire
 - Date horse retired
3. Qualifying Shows must be affiliated with VAS Ltd
4. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden
5. Once a qualifier is won, the horses cannot compete in other qualifiers
6. All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Off the Track series Final to be held at the 2016 VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships in January 2016 (date to be determined)
7. Riders to be 14 years and over on day of qualifying show
8. To be judged as a good example of Thoroughbreds rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration:
 - Thoroughbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - Manners, paces and performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
9. Judges decision is final in qualifiers and final
10. Qualifier Prizes: \$50, sash, card and Racing Victoria Prize Pack

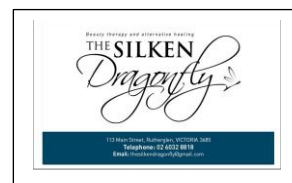

****"Good Hands winners are eligible to compete for the Challenge Trophies at the 2013 VAS Ltd "Weight Lifter" Saddle Horse Championship Show. The holder of a VAS Ltd Good Hands Qualifying Certificate, won in the same year, shall not be eligible to compete. The Competitors shall be judged solely on their riding ability – mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account. Special attention will be paid to hands and seat, general management and control of the horse or pony. Competitors must ride using an ordinary snaffle, single jointed in the centre, the mouthpiece must be smooth and of the one metal, with or without a cavesson noseband. A gear check may take place. NOTE: Straight bar snaffle, drop nosebands, whips and spurs not allowed.**

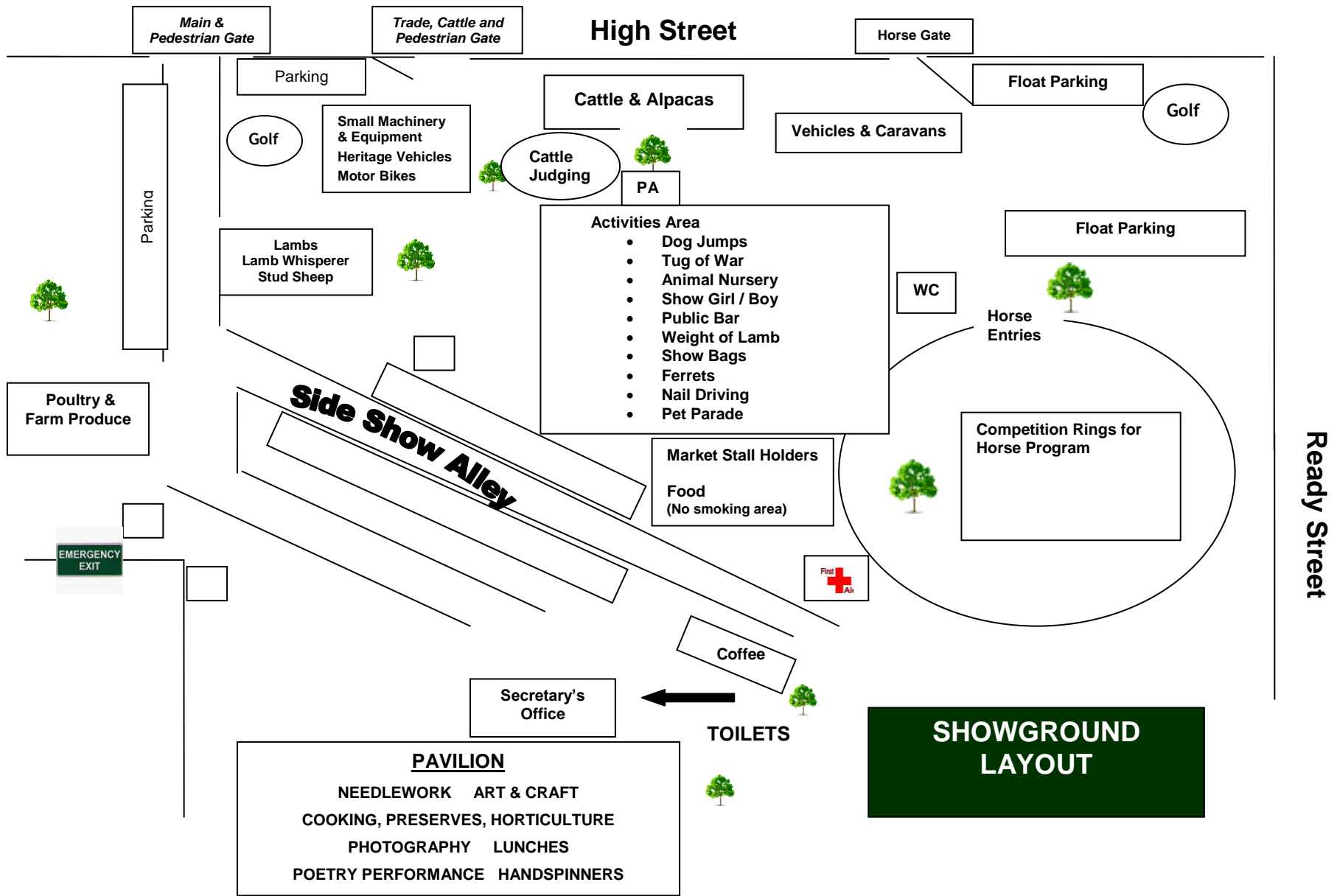
